



**TUTIMA**  
PATRIA

Above all else, the Tutima Patria represents tradition. The Patria follows a long line of unassuming yet exquisitely handcrafted watches that have been produced in Germany for generations.

Fashioned from 18K rose gold, the 43mm case is gently rounded and robust. The opaline, silver-plated dial has a fine granular texture we find very appealing. A subtle sink in the center adds an understated yet refined detail, while a deeper sink with a snailed finish underlies the oversize sub-seconds display.

The manual-winding movement naturally uses a three-quarter-plate construction, decorated with broad Glashütte stripes and

polished, beveled edges. The movement runs at 21,600vph in 20 jewels, three of which are set in screw-mounted gold chatons. The prominent crown and ratchet wheels are decorated with an iridescent sunburst finish. A unique click with a gently curved steel spring is another subtle reminder of the craftsman's skill found throughout this watch.

The free-sprung balance uses a weighted screw and four regulating screws in slotted, threaded holes. The openworked balance cock improves the view of the hairspring with its hand-formed Breguet overcoil. This is the essence of tradition.
