

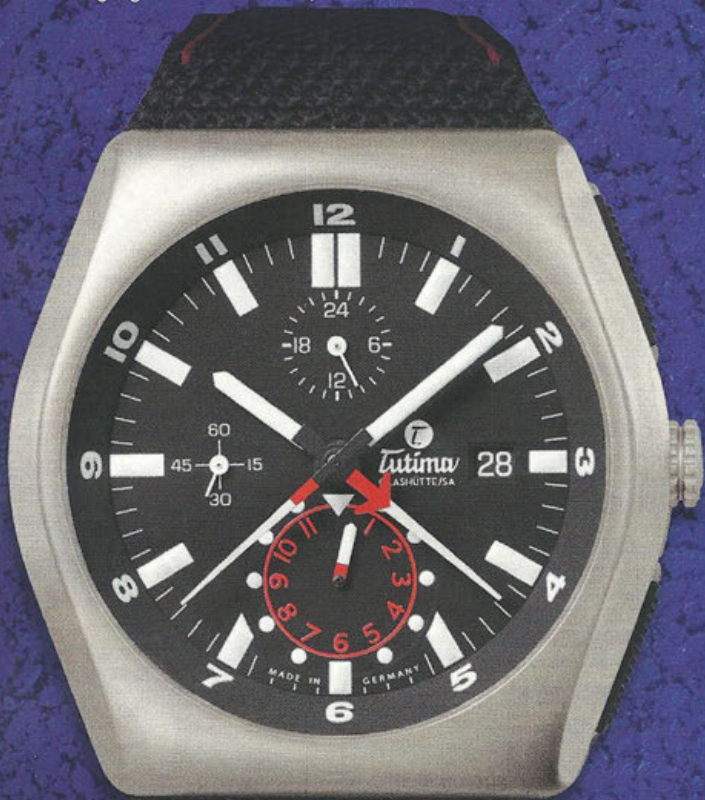
M2 PIONEER CHRONO

The M2 Pioneer Chrono is the largest of the M2 series, at 46.5mm in diameter. Also housing the Tutima 521 automatic movement, and offering 44 hours of power reserve, the watch features a bidirectional rotating 60-minute bezel with inserted luminescent capsules (on Pioneer models) for easy readability. Like the M2 Chrono, it offers time indication, chronograph functions and 24-hour display. It's soft iron inner case protects it from magnetic fields and it is water resistant to 300 meters. It is sold with a Kevlar strap or with a kit that includes a solid titanium bracelet, additional Kevlar strap and changing tool. **Retail: \$6,700.**



M2 CHRONO

The Tutima M2 Chrono is a superb blend of technical prowess, legible design and top German craftsmanship. The tonneau-shaped 46 mm titanium case features a circular dial that offers a modern take on a vintage look. The watch is powered by the Tutima caliber 521 automatic movement with 44 hours of power reserve. In addition to time and chronograph functions, the watch also offers 24-hour display. Its large neoprene inlaid chronograph buttons help protect it to 300 meters of water resistance, and a soft inner iron case protects it from magnetic fields. It is shown here on a Kevlar strap. **Retail: \$5,900.**



M2 SEVEN SEAS

German brand Tutima has been steadily building its in-house-made calibers and its watch lineup. The new M2 Seven Seas watch is a deft example of craftsmanship, form and function. It houses the automatic movement, caliber T330, that offers hour, minutes, sweep second and day/date display. The movement features an antique gray rotor with 750 gold seal and offers 38 hours of power reserve. Crafted of solid titanium, the 44mm watch is pressure tested to 50 bar, features a unidirectional rotating bezel, luminous calibrations and indexes, a sapphire anti-reflective case and screw-in crown. It is offered on a titanium bracelet or rugged Kevlar strap. **Retail: \$1,900.**
