One of the real trends at Baselworld this year was towards value, getting a lot of watch for your money. Well, the M2 Seven Seas from Tutima has that in spades.

The M2 Seven Seas offers professional 500m water resistance in a watch that is incredibly affordable: \$2,100 on a strap!

Housed in a 44mm titanium case, complete with a 3mm-thick sapphire crystal, a screw-down crown and screwed-in caseback, this ultralight but tremendously rugged automatic timepiece is water-resistant to 500m, easily passing the 200m standard for diving watches. The unidirectional rotating bezel and double anti-reflective coating, guaranteeing incredible visibility underwater, complete the picture of this professional dive watch. On the simple yet very attractive dial are indications for the day of the week and the date, something not typically found on a dive watch, making this timepiece even more versatile.

Available on a Kevlar strap or solid-titanium bracelet, the M2 Seven Seas from Tutima provides everything you could want in a sporty watch, including German design and engineering, at an incredible price.
