

TUTIMA SAXON ONE CHRONOGRAPH

Tutima, based in Glashütte, Germany, has modified the automatic movement that powers its chronograph, which boasts the brand's characteristic cushion-shaped case. Now this caliber animates the elapsed-minutes counter from the dial's center and also supports a 24-hour display. The dial follows the arrangement dictated by Lemania Caliber 5001, whose production was discontinued in the 1990s.
