



Tutima

— A freshly minted in-house chronograph movement, Caliber T659, powers Tutima's new Tempstopp. The movement was inspired by the well-known Caliber 59, which the Glashütte-based ébauche maker UROFA introduced during World War II. Tutima used Caliber 59 in its famous Flieger Chronograph. Caliber 59, like Caliber T659, had a flyback function. In German this function was called a "tempstopp"; hence the new watch's name. Caliber T659 is manually wound and has a column wheel. It is decorated with a variety of finishes and has a power reserve of 65 hours. The case is rose gold and 43 mm in diameter. The watch is being manufactured in a limited series of 90 pieces to commemorate Tutima's 90th anniversary. Price: \$29,500.
